This bias chart was designed by Shotbowl to assist bowlers with understanding the bias between bowls from different manufacturers. These comparisons are made as guidance only and appreciation must be allowed for variations in the playing surface and delivery action.

Thomas Taylor Lazer

Slimline Indoor model with minimum bias. Having a lenient, constant gentle draw to the jack with no hook at the end, making it ideal for front-end bowlers.

Drakes Pride Advantage

Playing a fraction wider than the Lazer, still with no hook at the finish.

Aero Defiance

Playing a fraction wider than the Lazer, still with no hook at the finish.

Thomas Taylor Vector VS.

*Playing a slightly wider than the 3 above, with slightly more finish. **Our best selling Indoor bowl.***

Aero Profile

A mid range indoor bowl, plays a similar width to the Blaze but has a more constant bias and is a slim-line bowl.

Drakes Pride B-Tec

A mid range indoor bowl, plays a similar width to the Blaze but has a more constant finish into the head.

Henselite Tiger 2

A mid range indoor bowl, plays a similar width to the Blaze but has a more constant finish into the head.

Thomas Taylor Blaze

A versatile mid range indoor bowl which has a noticeable stronger finish.

Aero Quantum

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors. Plays as wide as the ace but has a constant bias.

Aimark Sterling Slim-line

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors. Made from a slightly heavier compound so roughly a few grams heavier.

Henselite Classic 2

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front end bowlers outdoors. The shoulder is slightly forward creating a stronger finish, commonly known as it's hockey stick finish.

Henselite Tiger Pro

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front - mid end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors.

Drakes Pride Professional

*A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front - mid end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors. **One of the most popular bowls in the UK.***

Thomas Taylor Ace

*A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front - mid end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a slightly stronger finish outdoors than the group above playing slightly wider than the Drake Pride Professional. **One of the most popular bowls in the UK.***

Henselite Tiger Evo

Aimed at back end bowlers on slower running indoor greens, generally more suited to back end bowlers outdoors. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Drakes Pride XP

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Thomas Taylor International

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Henselite Tiger

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Aero Groove

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers. Has a constant bias.

Thomas Taylor Vector

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers and is the slimline Outdoor Model from Taylors.

Aero Profile

Aimed at back end outdoors bowlers. Has a constant bias.

Thomas Taylor Lignoid

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers and is one of the widest swinging bowls available with a strong hook finish.

Henselite Classic

Aimed at back end outdoors bowlers. The famous 'hockey stick bias' is an excellent wide drawing bowl for all outdoor surfaces.

Aero Maxim

Aimed at back end outdoors bowlers. Has a constant bias.
